## Recording Audio Files and Creating QR Codes using GarageBand, Dropbox and qrstuff.com [...and maybe iPhoto]

Open GarageBand.

Choose New Project and Select Voice.

Save project file on your hard drive...and remember where you have saved it.

Click red round Record Button and begin recording.

Click Stop Button to end your recording.

When finished recording, click Share, then Export to Disk. Compress using MP3 encoder. Export.

Upload MP3 file to a public folder on Dropbox. Click on the file in the public folder. Copy public link.

Go to www.qrstuff.com (or any other QR code generator) [These directions are for www.qrstuff.com]

- 1. Date type...click on Dropbox.
- 2. Content...paste the public link in the Website URL box. Click on "Use our qrs.ly URL shortener".
- 3. You can select the color of your code. [I just always use black.]
- 4. Download the QR Code. [I download the QR Codes, then rename the file with the student's name and drag the files into iPhoto to print a bunch of them at one time as a Contact Sheet with the file name printed below the image.]
